Don't have honey to enter? Then come to taste the surprisingly wide varieties of honey that are produced in our area and be one of our judges.

At the beginning of our November meeting you will have the opportunity to pour your honey into an official entry jar (1/2 pound glass queenline jar) if you did not pick up a jar during the October club meeting. (Note: you should provide enough honey to completely fill the jar.)

You can enter one jar per family from this year's honey crop. Each jar will be assigned a random number so no one will know whose honey they are judging. Everyone will get a chance to be a judge. At the end of the meeting the names of the winners will be revealed and ribbons given out for the best tasting honey. You **MUST ATTEND** the October meeting to enter the contest.

Honey entry requirements

- Current member of the club.
- Honey from this year's extraction.
- One Jar of honey per family
- Honey from hives in Mecklenburg or surrounding counties.
- Bottled in a clean ½ pound glass queen line jar filled to the top supplied by the club.
- No markings on the jar which would identify the owner.
- Must be present to win.
